HorsePower Australia and its affiliated member centres provide a range of services, programs and events aimed at empowering people living with diverse abilities to develop new skills, discover new abilities and define the life they want to live. As you can imagine providing programs that utilise horses can be very costly. Participants fees only cover a percentage of the actual cost of providing our programs, the rest of the funds are raised through donations from individuals, corporations and foundations, through grants and fundraising events/activities.

Please note HorsePower Australia will be transitioning out of being an NDIS Registered Provider in 2022. We will continue to provide services utilising NDIS funding to those participants who are Plan or Self managed. If you have any concerns about this please contact HorsePower Australia on 0475 217 453 or at admin@horsepower.org.au and we will do our best to assist and support you during this transition.

Our staff, coaches and volunteers commit a significant amount of time to plan and prepare for sessions before you even arrive at a HorsePower centre so we ask that participants commit financially to each session and provide at least 48 hours notice if they are unable to attend.

Thanks to our volunteers and support from the community through donations and fundraising activities we will continue to try and keep the costs of our programs as low as possible however we do still have certain overheads to cover including the care of our horses and ponies and properties, therefore the fees represented below are a percentage of the "true" cost of our programs.

We understand that in today's financial climate if you are not eligible for government funding that you may experience financial difficulty and be unable to fund sessions at these costs on an ongoing basis. HorsePower Australia and its affiliated member centres aim to support as many people as we can, therefore *if you are experiencing financial difficulty please contact your local HorsePower centre to discuss your situation they may be able to assist you in sourcing funding to participate in our programs or thanks to their local volunteer fundraising efforts be able to offer you a scholarship or grant to assist you in accessing our programs.*
