HorsePower Australia and its affiliated member centres provide a range of services, programs and events aimed at empowering people living with diverse abilities to develop new skills, discover new abilities and define the life they want to live. As you can imagine providing programs that utilise horses can be very costly. Participants fees only cover a percentage of the actual cost of providing our programs, the rest of the funds are raised through donations from individuals, corporations and foundations, through grants and fundraising events/activities.

HorsePower Australia and its affiliated centres are transitioning out of state government funding to NDIS funding, therefore session fees are no longer being subsidised by the WA Government. HorsePower Australia (previously known as Riding for the Disabled Association of Western Australia) encourages participants who are eligible for NDIS funding to include their sessions in their plan under Assistance to Access Community, Social and Recreational Activities or Increase Social and Community Participation.

Thanks to our volunteers and support from the community we will continue to try and keep the costs of our programs as low as possible however we do still have certain overheads to cover including the care of our horses and ponies therefore we adjust our fee schedule to align with updated pricing from the NDIA. We understand that in today's financial climate if you are not eligible for government funding that you may experience financial difficulty and be unable to fund lessons at these costs on an ongoing basis. HorsePower Australia and its affiliated member centres aim to support as many people as we can, therefore ***if you are experiencing financial difficulty please contact your local HorsePower centre to discuss your situation they may be able to assist you in sourcing funding to participate in our programs or thanks to their local volunteer fundraising efforts be able to offer you a scholarship or grant to assist you in accessing our programs.***

Annual Fees

All participants must pay an annual of six monthly insurance levy and HorsePower Australia membership fee.
